Hello fellow flyers,

Hope you all had a great Christmas and New Year.

• 25 members have renewed for 2025 so far. With our 4 club officers, that gives us a membership count of 29 people. 38 members from 2024 have not yet renewed. Andy Berger joined ERCA at the end of December. Welcome to the club Andy!

- The club officers and event manager (Ken) have put together a schedule for 2025 events. (See **coming events**) in this newsletter.
- Martin has put together a summary of the club's income and expenses for 2024. If anyone wants to dig in deeper or has any specific questions, please let Martin know.
- Martin is proposing a change to the club's bylaws to move membership to 12-month annual membership, rather than the current calendar year-based model. See the details below. This has several advantages:
- It reduces the workload for processing membership renewals, as they will not all happen in the same couple of months each year.
- \odot We can investigate things like multi-year membership renewals (like the AMA offers).
- \odot We do not have to prorate membership at all.
- Members could renew their club membership at the same time as they renew their AMA membership if they wish.
- We can move to creating membership badges and mailing them out on receipt of member dues.

A couple of members have asked about why we do calendar year-based membership when many organizations (including the AMA) have moved to membership based on enrollment date.

I am considering proposing at the January meeting that we move to membership based on 12 months from enrollment date.

All existing members would still have a renewal date of 12/31 but for new members moving forwards we can have their membership go from the date they enroll for a whole 12 months. For example, someone joining on July 17th, 2025, would have their membership renewal on July 17th, 2026. This would reduce the renewal workload at the end of the calendar year and will mean we will not need to pro-rate the first year for new members who join in the middle of the year. That's always felt a little odd to me.

Our membership rules are enshrined in the by-laws, so this would require amending the by-laws. I wanted to run my proposed changes to the by-laws past the club officers before proposing them at the January meeting.

If they look okay, I can announce the proposal at the January and February meetings, and then we can go for a vote at the March meeting. The rules for changing the By-laws are details in Article X of the By-Laws:

ARTICLE X AMENDMENTS

Section 1: No part of these By-Laws shall be repealed, altered, annulled or amended, unless a proposition, in writing, be made at two regular meetings prior to the time of its being acted upon. If two-thirds of the members present vote in favor of such proposed amendment, it shall be adopted. My proposed changes are detailed in the attached document, highlighted in yellow.

I would also propose to move to having the membership expiry date on the membership card (rather than the current approach of putting the year on the card).

Let me know what you guys think. Is this a suitable change? Is there anything unclear in the proposed new wording for the by-laws? Thanks, Martin
